Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Livermore Sewer Extension Protect Ground Water Project. The entity to receive funding for this project is Alameda County Public Works, located at 399 Elmhurst Street, Hayward, CA 94544. The funding would be used for an extension of the city's sewer services into the agricultural preserve to protect the ground water quality, enable further agricultural growth through the areas rich viticulture industry, and allow for full implementation of the vision of the South Livermore Valley Area Plan.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds as demonstrated by a recent study, conducted by the University of California, Davis - California Agricultural Issues Laboratory, which concluded that the South Livermore Valley Wine industry is not sustainable without near term actions including the provision of wastewater services for the wine producers in the area.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
