I am requesting funding for the Traffic Safety Improvements at Dusterberry Community Park project in fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Fremont, located at P.O. Box 5006, Fremont, CA 94537. The funding would be used to transform these streets to be more neighborhood-friendly and support people walking and bicycling to the park and throughout the neighborhood. Features of the project include replacing the old traffic signals with a roundabout, adding pedestrian flashing beacons, and installing landscaping, for improved safety, lower traffic speeds, and better aesthetics. Dusterberry Community Park was designed for the community to walk and bike to. The intersection improvements along Dusterberry Way and Peralta Boulevard will provide safer walking and bicycling access to and from the community park.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
