I am requesting funding for the City of Livermore Multi-Service Center Upgrades project in fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Livermore, located at 1052 S. Livermore Ave., Livermore, CA 94550. The funding would be used for renovations to significantly expand and improve the service provision of providers housed in the MSC, a regional hub that provides housing assistance, behavioral health care, early childhood education, disability services, and homelessness support. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because co-locating these services in the MSC has a two-fold benefit – people in need can access a variety of services in one place, and the service providers incur significantly reduced administrative costs.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
