
I am requesting funding for the St. Regis Multi-Service Campus Project in Fiscal Year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Hayward, 777 B Street Hayward, CA 94541.

The project will assist Bay Area Community Services (BACS) in rehabilitating the existing facilities at a former assisted living facility, St. Regis, into a supportive housing center. The requested funding will provide the last dollars necessary for this critical and necessary facility to house and help the homeless population.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will greatly expand the number of beds available in Hayward and Alameda County. The requested funding will provide the last dollars necessary for this critical facility to house and help the homeless population. This project will increase the total bed capacity in Hayward by 206 beds, more than doubling local capacity, improving the lives of those who have historically been underserved and underrepresented in the community.
